

ALLELE FREQUENCY BIOLOGY

DEFINITION AND SIGNIFICANCE

POPULATIONS WITH HIGH GENETIC DIVERSITY ARE TYPICALLY MORE RESILIENT TO ENVIRONMENTAL CHANGES, MAKING ALLELE FREQUENCY A KEY FACTOR IN CONSERVATION BIOLOGY. FURTHERMORE, ALLELE FREQUENCIES CAN INDICATE THE PRESENCE OF CERTAIN TRAITS OR DISEASES WITHIN A POPULATION, MAKING IT A VITAL TOOL IN MEDICAL GENETICS AND EPIDEMIOLOGY.

CALCULATING ALLELE FREQUENCY

THE CALCULATION OF ALLELE FREQUENCY CAN BE STRAIGHTFORWARD IF ONE UNDERSTANDS THE BASIC CONCEPTS OF POPULATION GENETICS. THE FORMULA FOR CALCULATING THE FREQUENCY OF AN ALLELE (P) IS:

$$P = \frac{\text{(NUMBER OF COPIES OF THE ALLELE IN THE POPULATION)}}{\text{(TOTAL NUMBER OF ALL ALLELES FOR THAT GENE IN THE POPULATION)}}$$

TO ILLUSTRATE THIS CALCULATION, CONSIDER A POPULATION OF PEA PLANTS WHERE THE GENE FOR FLOWER COLOR HAS TWO ALLELES: A (DOMINANT) AND a (RECESSIVE). IF THERE ARE 20 PLANTS, AND THE GENOTYPES ARE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:

- 10 AA
- 5 Aa
- 5 aa

CALCULATING THE ALLELE FREQUENCIES INVOLVES DETERMINING THE NUMBER OF EACH ALLELE:

- FOR ALLELE A: $(2 \times 10) + (1 \times 5) = 25$
- FOR ALLELE a: $(2 \times 5) + (1 \times 5) = 15$

THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ALLELES IS 40 (2 ALLELES PER PLANT). THUS, THE FREQUENCIES ARE:

- FREQUENCY OF A (P) = $25/40 = 0.625$ OR 62.5%
- FREQUENCY OF a (Q) = $15/40 = 0.375$ OR 37.5%

THIS SIMPLE CALCULATION ALLOWS BIOLOGISTS TO TRACK CHANGES IN ALLELE FREQUENCY OVER GENERATIONS, WHICH IS ESSENTIAL FOR STUDYING EVOLUTION.

FACTORS INFLUENCING ALLELE FREQUENCY
