IT PROVIDES HIGH-RESOLUTION STRUCTURES BUT REQUIRES THAT THE PROTEIN BE CRYSTALLIZED, WHICH CAN BE CHALLENGING FOR SOME PROTEINS.

NUCLEAR MAGNETIC RESONANCE (NMR) SPECTROSCOPY

NMR SPECTROSCOPY ALLOWS SCIENTISTS TO STUDY PROTEINS IN SOLUTION, PROVIDING INSIGHTS INTO THEIR DYNAMICS AND INTERACTIONS IN A MORE NATIVE-LIKE ENVIRONMENT. THIS TECHNIQUE IS PARTICULARLY USEFUL FOR SMALLER PROTEINS AND CAN YIELD INFORMATION ABOUT FLEXIBLE REGIONS THAT X-RAY CRYSTALLOGRAPHY MIGHT MISS.

CRYO-ELECTRON MICROSCOPY (CRYO-EM)

CRYO-EM HAS GAINED POPULARITY DUE TO ITS ABILITY TO VISUALIZE LARGE PROTEIN COMPLEXES WITHOUT THE NEED FOR CRYSTALLIZATION. IN THIS TECHNIQUE, SAMPLES ARE RAPIDLY FROZEN, AND THE ELECTRON MICROSCOPE CAPTURES IMAGES OF THE PROTEINS IN THEIR NATIVE STATE. THIS METHOD OFFERS A BALANCE BETWEEN RESOLUTION AND THE ABILITY TO STUDY LARGER STRUCTURES.

TYPES OF PROTEIN STRUCTURES

PROTEINS CAN BE CATEGORIZED BASED ON THEIR STRUCTURAL CHARACTERISTICS, WHICH CAN BE EFFECTIVELY ILLUSTRATED THROUGH IMAGES. UNDERSTANDING THESE STRUCTURES IS VITAL FOR COMPREHENDING PROTEIN FUNCTIONALITY.
