

STAGHORN CALCULUS MEANING

STAGHORN CALCULUS MEANING REFERS TO A SPECIFIC TYPE OF KIDNEY STONE THAT IS CHARACTERIZED BY ITS LARGE, BRANCHING STRUCTURE RESEMBLING THE HORNS OF A STAG. OTHER COMPONENTS CAN INCLUDE CALCIUM OXALATE AND CALCIUM PHOSPHATE, PARTICULARLY IN CASES ASSOCIATED WITH METABOLIC DISORDERS.

CAUSES OF STAGHORN CALCULUS
