4. **SEPARATION COMPLETION:** ENSURE THAT MOST OF THE LIQUID HAS BEEN TRANSFERRED WHILE LEAVING THE SOLID OR THE BOTTOM LAYER BEHIND.
5. **POST-DECANTING ANALYSIS:** ANALYZE THE SEPARATED LIQUID AND SOLID FOR FURTHER APPLICATIONS OR EXPERIMENTS.

## DECANTING VS. OTHER SEPARATION TECHNIQUES
