- **SYMMETRY DEGENERACY:** SYMMETRY IN MOLECULAR STRUCTURES CAN LEAD TO DEGENERACY. FOR INSTANCE, IN SYMMETRICAL MOLECULES, CERTAIN VIBRATIONS MAY HAVE THE SAME ENERGY DUE TO THE SYMMETRICAL ARRANGEMENT OF ATOMS.

## THE ROLE OF DEGENERACY IN CHEMICAL REACTIONS

DEGENERACY ALSO PLAYS A CRUCIAL ROLE IN CHEMICAL REACTIONS. IN TRANSITION STATES, FOR EXAMPLE, THE DEGENERACY OF ENERGY LEVELS CAN AFFECT HOW REACTANTS TRANSFORM INTO PRODUCTS.
