

QUANTIZATION MEANING IN CHEMISTRY

BOHR'S MODEL OF THE ATOM

IN 1913, NIELS BOHR BUILT UPON THESE IDEAS WITH HIS MODEL OF THE HYDROGEN ATOM, INTRODUCING QUANTIZED ORBITS FOR ELECTRONS. BOHR'S MODEL SUCCESSFULLY EXPLAINED THE SPECTRAL LINES OF HYDROGEN, SUPPORTING THE IDEA THAT ELECTRONS CAN ONLY EXIST IN CERTAIN ENERGY STATES.

MATHEMATICAL FRAMEWORK OF QUANTIZATION

QUANTUM NUMBERS

QUANTIZATION IS ALSO DESCRIBED BY QUANTUM NUMBERS, WHICH ARISE FROM SOLVING THE SCHRÖDINGER EQUATION FOR DIFFERENT SYSTEMS. THE PRINCIPAL QUANTUM NUMBER (n), ANGULAR MOMENTUM QUANTUM NUMBER (l), MAGNETIC QUANTUM NUMBER (m), AND SPIN QUANTUM NUMBER (s) PROVIDE A COMPLETE SET OF VALUES THAT CHARACTERIZE THE DISTINCT ENERGY STATES OF ELECTRONS IN AN ATOM.

- **PRINCIPAL QUANTUM NUMBER (n):** INDICATES THE MAIN ENERGY LEVEL OF AN ELECTRON.
- **ANGULAR MOMENTUM QUANTUM NUMBER (l):** RELATES TO THE SHAPE OF THE ORBITAL.
- **MAGNETIC QUANTUM NUMBER (m):** CORRESPONDS TO THE ORIENTATION OF THE ORBITAL.
- **SPIN QUANTUM NUMBER (s):** REPRESENTS THE INTRINSIC SPIN OF THE ELECTRON.

APPLICATIONS OF QUANTIZATION IN CHEMISTRY
