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INTRODUCTION TO ORGANIC REAGENTS

CLASSIFICATION OF ORGANIC REAGENTS

BASED ON PHYSICAL STATE

REAGENTS CAN ALSO BE CATEGORIZED BY THEIR PHYSICAL STATES, INCLUDING:

- **SOLIDS:** REAGENTS THAT ARE SOLID AT ROOM TEMPERATURE.
- **LIQUIDS:** REAGENTS THAT ARE LIQUIDS AT ROOM TEMPERATURE.
- **GASES:** REAGENTS THAT EXIST IN GASEOUS FORM.

COMMON TYPES OF REAGENTS

OXIDIZING AND REDUCING AGENTS

OXIDIZING AND REDUCING AGENTS PLAY CRUCIAL ROLES IN REDOX REACTIONS, WHERE THE TRANSFER OF ELECTRONS OCCURS.

- **COMMON OXIDIZING AGENTS:** POTASSIUM PERMANGANATE, CHROMIUM TRIOXIDE, AND HYDROGEN PEROXIDE ARE WIDELY USED TO OXIDIZE ALCOHOLS TO CARBONYL COMPOUNDS.
- **COMMON REDUCING AGENTS:** LITHIUM ALUMINUM HYDRIDE AND SODIUM BOROHYDRIDE ARE EFFECTIVE AT REDUCING CARBONYL COMPOUNDS TO ALCOHOLS.

SOLVENTS

SOLVENTS ARE NOT REAGENTS IN THE TRADITIONAL SENSE, BUT THEY ARE ESSENTIAL FOR CREATING THE RIGHT ENVIRONMENT FOR REACTIONS. THE CHOICE OF SOLVENT CAN SIGNIFICANTLY IMPACT THE REACTION RATE AND PRODUCT FORMATION.

- **POLAR PROTIC SOLVENTS:** WATER AND ALCOHOLS CAN STABILIZE IONS, ENHANCING NUCLEOPHILIC AND ELECTROPHILIC ATTACKS.
- **POLAR APROTIC SOLVENTS:** DIMETHYL SULFOXIDE (DMSO) AND ACETONITRILE CAN FACILITATE REACTIONS WITHOUT THE INTERFERENCE OF HYDROGEN BONDING.
- **NON-POLAR SOLVENTS:** HEXANE AND TOLUENE ARE OFTEN USED FOR REACTIONS INVOLVING NON-POLAR REACTANTS.

SPECIFIC EXAMPLES OF REAGENTS

GRIGNARD REAGENTS

REAGENTS FOR FUNCTIONAL GROUP TRANSFORMATIONS

NUMEROUS REAGENTS FACILITATE THE TRANSFORMATION OF FUNCTIONAL GROUPS IN ORGANIC MOLECULES.

- **LiAlH₄**: A STRONG REDUCING AGENT THAT CAN REDUCE ESTERS, CARBOXYLIC ACIDS, AND ALDEHYDES TO ALCOHOLS.
- **SOCl₂**: THIONYL CHLORIDE IS COMMONLY USED TO CONVERT ALCOHOLS INTO ALKYL CHLORIDES.

IMPORTANCE OF REAGENTS IN ORGANIC CHEMISTRY
