DEFINITION OF AN ELECTRODE

IN ESSENCE, ELECTRODES ACT AS INTERFACES BETWEEN THE ELECTRONIC AND IONIC CONDUCTION, ENABLING THE CONVERSION OF CHEMICAL ENERGY INTO ELECTRICAL ENERGY OR VICE VERSA.

THE DESIGN AND FUNCTIONALITY OF ELECTRODES ARE INTEGRAL TO THE EFFICIENCY OF ELECTROCHEMICAL PROCESSES. - **INDICATOR ELECTRODES:** THESE ELECTRODES RESPOND TO THE CONCENTRATION OF SPECIFIC IONS IN A SOLUTION. A TYPICAL EXAMPLE IS THE GLASS ELECTRODE, USED FOR MEASURING pH LEVELS.
- **WORKING ELECTRODES:** THESE ARE ELECTRODES WHERE THE MAIN ELECTROCHEMICAL REACTION OCCURS. THEY CAN BE EITHER INERT OR ACTIVE BASED ON THE REACTIONS THEY FACILITATE.

FUNCTIONS OF ELECTRODES IN ELECTROCHEMICAL CELLS

IN ELECTROCHEMICAL CELLS, ELECTRODES SERVE SEVERAL CRUCIAL FUNCTIONS THAT ARE ESSENTIAL FOR THE CELL'S OPERATION. THE PRIMARY FUNCTIONS INCLUDE:

THIS PARTICIPATION IS CRITICAL FOR THE OVERALL REACTION AND ENERGY CONVERSION PROCESS.

POTENTIAL ESTABLISHMENT
