UNDERSTANDING CARBON'S ROLE IN ORGANIC CHEMISTRY IS ESSENTIAL FOR FIELDS RANGING FROM BIOCHEMISTRY TO MATERIALS SCIENCE.

PROPERTIES OF CARBON

CARBON EXHIBITS UNIQUE PROPERTIES THAT CONTRIBUTE TO ITS CENTRAL ROLE IN ORGANIC CHEMISTRY. ONE OF THE PRIMARY CHARACTERISTICS OF CARBON IS ITS TETRAVALENCY, WHICH ALLOWS IT TO FORM FOUR COVALENT BONDS WITH OTHER ATOMS. ALLOTROPES OF CARBON

CARBON EXISTS IN SEVERAL ALLOTROPES, EACH WITH DISTINCT PROPERTIES THAT IMPACT THEIR USES IN ORGANIC CHEMISTRY.

- **DIAMOND:** A THREE-DIMENSIONAL STRUCTURE WHERE EACH CARBON ATOM IS BONDED TO FOUR OTHERS, RESULTING IN EXCEPTIONAL HARDNESS AND THERMAL CONDUCTIVITY.
- **GRAPHITE:** COMPOSED OF LAYERS OF CARBON ATOMS ARRANGED IN A HEXAGONAL LATTICE, MAKING IT A GOOD CONDUCTOR OF ELECTRICITY AND USEFUL AS A LUBRICANT.
- **GRAPHENE:** A SINGLE LAYER OF CARBON ATOMS BONDED IN A TWO-DIMENSIONAL HONEYCOMB LATTICE, NOTED FOR ITS

STRENGTH AND ELECTRICAL CONDUCTIVITY.

- **FULLERENES:** SPHERICAL MOLECULES MADE ENTIRELY OF CARBON, KNOWN FOR THEIR UNIQUE PROPERTIES AND POTENTIAL APPLICATIONS IN NANOTECHNOLOGY.

COVALENT BONDING AND HYBRIDIZATION

THE ABILITY OF CARBON TO FORM STABLE COVALENT BONDS IS A DIRECT RESULT OF ITS ELECTRONIC CONFIGURATION. WITH FOUR VALENCE ELECTRONS, CARBON CAN UNDERGO HYBRIDIZATION, FORMING sp^3 , sp^2 , OR sp HYBRID ORBITALS. THIS HYBRIDIZATION FACILITATES THE FORMATION OF SINGLE, DOUBLE, AND TRIPLE BONDS, ALLOWING FOR DIVERSE MOLECULAR ARCHITECTURES.

TYPES OF ORGANIC COMPOUNDS

FUNCTIONAL GROUPS

FUNCTIONAL GROUPS ARE SPECIFIC GROUPS OF ATOMS THAT IMPART CHARACTERISTIC CHEMICAL PROPERTIES TO ORGANIC MOLECULES. SOME KEY FUNCTIONAL GROUPS INCLUDE:

- **ALCOHOLS:** CONTAIN HYDROXYL ($-OH$) GROUPS.
- **ALDEHYDES:** CONTAIN A CARBONYL GROUP ($C=O$) AT THE END OF A CARBON CHAIN.
- **CARBOXYLIC ACIDS:** CONTAIN A CARBOXYL GROUP ($-COOH$).
- **AMINES:** DERIVATIVES OF AMMONIA WITH ONE OR MORE HYDROGEN ATOMS REPLACED BY ALKYL OR ARYL GROUPS.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE OF ORGANIC CHEMISTRY

ORGANIC CHEMISTRY HAS A RICH HISTORY THAT REFLECTS THE EVOLUTION OF SCIENTIFIC THOUGHT. THE TERM 'ORGANIC CHEMISTRY' WAS FIRST USED IN THE EARLY 19TH CENTURY, PRIMARILY ASSOCIATED WITH COMPOUNDS DERIVED FROM LIVING
